Quartiles are the three values—the first

quartile at 25% (Q1), the second quartile at 50% (Q2 or median), and the third quartile at 75% (Q3)—that divide a sample of ordered data into four equal parts. The first quartile is the 25th percentile and indicates that 25% of the data are less than or equal to this value.
