When questionable viability of tissue prohibits manual reduction, rectal resection and anastomosis are required. When rectal tissue is viable but not amenable to manual reduction, celiotomy followed by colopexy is indicated to prevent recurrence. As in medical management, epidural anesthesia may be used to reduce straining.

A posterior vaginal prolapse, also known as a rectocele, occurs when the wall of fibrous tissue that separates the rectum from the vagina weakens. When this happens, tissues or structures just behind the vaginal wall — in this case, the rectum — can bulge into the vagina.

Place your child on his stomach across a firm surface or your lap before taking his temperature. Gently slide the probe of the thermometer into the rectum about a 1/2 inch. Stop inserting the thermometer if it becomes difficult to insert. Never force the thermometer into the rectum.

Management algorithm for parastomal hernia. Clinical history and physical examination can help to diagnose parastomal hernia in a majority of the cases. When the diagnosis is equivocal, a computed tomographic scan with oral contrast material can help identify the hernia. Most parastomal hernias do not require a surgical repair.
