Washington State Optician License Study

Licensed dispensing opticians whose three-year continuing education reporting cycle begins on or after June 1, 2015, must complete 30 hours of continuing education every three years. Of the 30 hours every three years, at least five hours must be completed in each of the three years and at least 15 of the credit hours must relate to contact lenses.

Dispensing Optician :: Washington State Department of Health

Washington offers its opticianry state license exam twice a year and is administered by the Washington State Dispensing Optician Examining Committee. Applicants must earn a passing score of 70 on the exam, which includes written and practical portions.

How to Become an Optician in Washington

If going to school full time is not an option for you, there is another way to be become a Licensed Dispensing Optician. Register with the state of Washington for the Dispensing Optician Apprentice program. You can also take online classes through Highline Community College, specifically designed to go along with your apprenticeship.

How to Become an Optician - Opticianry in Washington

Licensing exams are offered twice a year in Washington and are administered by the Washington State Dispensing Optician Examining Committee. In order to pass the exam, which includes both written and practical portions, you will need to receive a score of at least a 70 percent.
